

Wiring Permits

Where electrical equipment has been replaced, such as panel boards, main switch, circuit breakers or branch circuit wiring, the Nova Scotia Electrical Code Regulations requires that the Electrical Contractor obtain a Wiring Permit from Nova Scotia Power and an inspection must be completed prior to equipment being energized.

In cases where the Provincial or Municipal Government officials declare "a state of emergency", Wiring Permit fees will be based on normal working hours charges. After hour emergency fees will not apply. However, in regards to water damage due to hydrant water, the Wiring Permit fees shall be as per NSPI schedule of fees and all other applicable fees apply.
